1. Finish strong

Seniors that earn a 3.5 total weighted GPA can apply for priority registration in the Spring too!

2. Study for the Accuplacer Exam

We will be conducting the Accuplacer exam on campus in April.

Follow these steps to start studying

- a) Login to your K16 Bridge account <http://www.k16bridge.org/mymentor/login.php?mess=>
- b) On the left menu bar click "College and Career Prep Tools"
- c) Click "Test Prep Powered by Peterson's"
- d) Click "***NEW** CPST"
- e) Click "College Placement Skills Training"
- f) Enter the access code "MyMentor11"
- g) START STUDYING!!

3. Plan your schedule for the Summer or Fall

Once the Fall schedule is available online at www.vvc.edu, usually sometime in April or May, you can go online and start to plan the days of the week and times you will take each class.

Follow these steps to plan your semester:

- a) Go to www.vvc.edu
- b) Click on "Webadvisor" on the left menu
- c) Click on "click here to go to Webadvisor now"
- d) On the left menu bar "Click here to view course offerings"
- e) Click on "Fall" for term
- f) Search for classes based on the Ed Plan you created with your counselor
- g) Complete the schedule on the back
- h) Come up with alternate classes (in July when you register, there's a possibility that your first choice won't be available – plan for that)

4. Check your Financial Aid Status on Webadvisor

In order to receive grants, scholarships, and loans you need to be sure your financial aid status is clear. It is your responsibility to check your status online via Webadvisor. Follow these steps to be sure you've submitted all documents needed to VVC's financial aid office:

- a) Go to www.vvc.edu
- b) Click on "Webadvisor" on the left menu
- c) Click on "click here to go to Webadvisor now"
- d) Click on the "students" menu
- e) Click on "My Documents" – if the Financial Aid office at VVC needs any documents from you (for example: a copy of your parent(s) taxes) it will be listed there
- f) Click on "Financial Aid Award Letter" – this letter lists your grants, scholarships, and loan totals for VVC – you will need to accept the student loans, if you are planning on using them.
